Introduction:

In Exodus 5:1-2, Moses and Aaron told Pharaoh, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel says: 'let my people go'..." Pharaoh replied, "**Who is the Lord that I should obey him** and let Israel go? **I do not know the Lord** and I will not let Israel go."

Today's society seems to echo Pharaoh's attitude towards God. Knowledge of who God is, and consequently, the desire to obey Him, is noticeably lacking.

God longs to have a close relationship with all people and He wants us to know Him intimately. His ultimate character, from His mighty power to His great love and compassion for all people, is revealed in the Bible.

This summer, we invite you to join us as we search God's word to deepen our understanding of who God really is, and what that means for our lives.

This year's Bible reading challenge has been written in a devotional format. Each week, we will read verses from both the Old and New Testaments that focus on a particular characteristic of God. I challenge you to think about the weekly readings in the context of the week's topic and meditate on how the chosen verses illuminate God's character. Most days also include a short thought about the day's reading, intended to provide additional focus and understanding for why the specific verses were chosen for that day.

As we get to know God better, I pray that our faith in Him will grow, and it will produce in us a greater desire to serve Him and share His truth.
